

## ACCESSORIES PATTERN AC17



### Knitted Bedsocks

Bedsocks are perfect for keeping toes snug at this time of year and craft stalls and hospitals welcome them. With a tie round the ankle these won't slip off in the night.

**Materials:** Approx. 70 grms DK wool and no.8 (4mm) needles

**Cast on** 79 stitches

**Row 1:** SI1, increase in next st. K37, increase in next st., K39

**Row 2:** SI1, increase in next st., K38, increase in next st., k40

Repeat these 2 rows, incorporating the extra stitches, until you have 99 stitches

Knit 8 rows without shaping

**Next Row:** SI1, k46, k2tog, k1, k2tog, k47

**Next Row:** SI1, k45, k2tog, p1, k2tog, k46

Repeat these 2 rows until 49sts remain

**Next Row:** SI1, k23, p1, k24

Proceed as follows:

**Row 1:** SI1, \*k1, wlfwd, k2tog, k1, repeat from \* to end of row

**Row 2:** SI1, \*pl, kl, repeat from \* to end of row

**Row 3:** SI1, \*kl, pl, repeat from \* to the last stitch, k1

Repeat the 2nd and 3rd rows 10 times, then 2nd row once

Cast off loosely in rib.

Sew up back and foot seam

Make a cord approx. 30in (76cm) long and thread through eyelets

For bigger socks add extra stitches at start
