

Magic Knot Instructions (SUPPLIED BY A MEMBER FROM DISS)

Using the two yarn ends which need joining, tie a single knot with yarn A a few inches along and around yarn B.

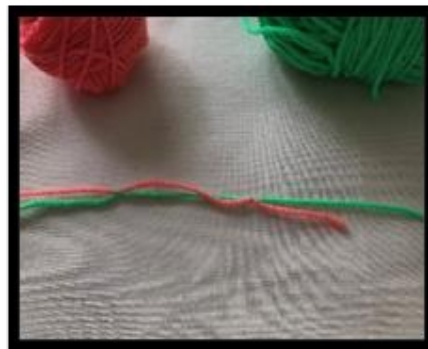
Then tie a similar single knot with yarn B a few inches along and around yarn A.

Make sure knots are tight.

Pull the two yarns together (holding the ends of the yarn which lead from the balls of yarn). ie, don't pull the two short ends!

I roll the knot between finger and thumb to try to make it as small as possible. Then cut the two short ends of yarn close to the knot.

I always check strength of knot by pulling/tugging hard. Then roll knot between finger and thumb again and continue knitting. A knot is a knot so not as smooth as a Russian join but so much quicker especially when having to keep joining ends!
