



Recycling Sac

This sac is perfect for storing those plastic carrier bags that we all like to save these days..... and it looks pretty, too. It is an excellent way to use scraps of material that are just not quite big enough for a morsbag.

Quick to sew, it only requires two rectangles of fabric approximately 9 by 24 inches, a strip for the handle 3 by 10 inches and some elastic.

- Make the handle by turning in the long raw edges and pressing.
- Fold the strip in half matching the pressed edges.
- Stitch them together close to the edge.
- Now with right sides together sew the two rectangles together to make a tube. Finish the edges. (or you could do a French seam)
- Turn in the top and bottom edges to form a casing for the elastic.
- Tuck the ends of the handle in the casing opposite each other.
- Machine stitch the casing, making sure you leave a gap to insert the elastic.
