

Cat, Dog and Rabbit Twiddle Muffs



5 mm needles and 100 grm of a soft & fluffy chunky yarn such a Snowflake or Yummy.

Tip: Knit the head, tail and ears first and if necessary use a different chunky yarn to finish the inside of the muff. If using super chunky yarn use larger sized needles and cast on a few less stitches for the muff.

Head

Cast on 10 sts and P to end.

Row 2. K front & back, (Kfb) in each st. to last st, K1. (19sts)

Row 3. K to end.

Row 4. (K1, Kfb) repeat to last st, K1. (28sts)

Row 5. K to end.

Row 6. (K2, Kfb) repeat to last st, K1. (37sts)

Rows 7 – 11. K 5 rows.

Row 12. (k2, K2tog) repeat to last st, K1. (28sts)

Row 13. K to end.

Row 14. (K1, K2tog) repeat to last st, K1. (19sts)

Row 15. K to end.

Row 16. k2tog to last st, K1. (10sts)

Row 17. K to end.

Row 18. k2tog to end (5sts)

Draw yarn through remaining sts.

Cat Ears

Cast on 5 sts and K 3 rows.

Row 4. K2 tog, k1, k2tog. **Row 5.** K to end.

Row 6. K2 tog, k1. **Row 7.** K2tog. Fasten off.

Dog Ears

Cast on 5 sts and K 8 rows .

Row 9. K2 tog, k1, k2tog. **Row 10.** K to end. **Row 11.** K2 tog, k1. **Row 12.** K2tog. Fasten off.

Rabbit Ears

Cast on 3 sts. **Row 1.** K. **Row 2.** K **Row 3.** K2, M1, K1. **Row 4.** K. **Row 5.** K. **Row 6.** K. **Row 7.** K1, M1, K2, M1, K1. **Rows 8 -20.** Knit 13 rows. **Row 21.** K2, K2tog, K2.

Rows 22 - 26. Knit 5 rows. **Row 27.** K2 tog, K1, K2tog. **Rows 28 -32.** Knit 5 rows. **Row 33.** K2tog, K1. **Row 34.** K. **Row 35.** K2tog. Fasten off.

Cat and Dog Tail

Cast on 20 sts. Knit 10 rows. Cast off loosely and sew up long seam.

Rabbit Tail

Cast on 8 Sts. Knit 3 rows. **Row 4.** K2 tog 4 times. Thread yarn through remaining sts. and draw up. Sew edges together and stuff.

Muff.

Cast on 40 sts, loosely and knit until work measures 40 cm. Cast off loosely.

Sew up side seam and join cast off edge to cast on edge making sure seam is not too tight. If using 2 different wools make sure it is in the centre inside the muff. Sew head seam and stuff and sew to rdge of muff. Sew on ears and tail very securely.

Embroider a smiley face.
