



Blanket Making

There are many ways of putting knitted squares together to make a blanket.

This is just one of them.



- If possible lay out a pattern on a flat surface, (e.g. a spare bed).
- Darn in any trailing ends on squares as you go.
- Crochet together with single overstitch in following pattern; this gives a flat appearance and also allows for longer runs without need to join wool. Not all squares are exactly the same size so remember to adjust as you go.



- Darn in trailing ends at edges of blanket.
- Edge in double crochet or a mixture of doubles and trebles.
