

Easy knitted edging for blankets

Every row is knit

Size 9/10 needles and DK yarn or Size 10/11 needles and 4ply yarn.
Smaller needles give a firmer finish. Depends on how tightly you knit.

Cast on 6 stitches

R 1 Knit 3 stitches, wool round needle, knit to end of the row.

R 2 Knit to end of the row.

Repeat these two rows until there are 12 stitches on the needle.

R 12 Cast off 6 stitches and knit to the end of the row.

These 12 rows form the pattern. Repeat till the strip is long enough to go around the edge of the blanket, stretching the edging a little when sewing round the corners
