

Granny Blanket corner to corner.



You can use any ply yarn with the appropriate hook size.

This blanket is approx 35" X 50" and took 700gms of dk yarn worked on a 4.5 mm hook.

Rnd 1: Work 4 tr into a magic ring.

3 ch and turn. Or ch 3 slip st to join and work 4 tr into middle of ring. Ch 3 and turn.

Rnd 2: Work 3 tr in space between 1st and 2nd trs and 4 tr in sp between last 2 trs. 3 ch and turn.

Rnd 3: 3 tr in sp between 1st and 2nd tr. 3 tr in space between the groups of trs and 4 tr in space between last 2 trs.

Repeat rnd 3 until blanket is as wide as you want it.

To decrease.

3 ch, miss space between first two sts and work three tr in next group sp.

Work to end of row working just one tr in space between last 2 trs.

Continue till last group of 3 tr and fasten off.

To make an oblong. Work until it is size required. Then decrease on one side and increase on the other until its the size required.

Then continue decreasing on both sides to finish off.

Optional border, work two rounds of $\frac{1}{2}$ trs all round working 2 sts into each space.
