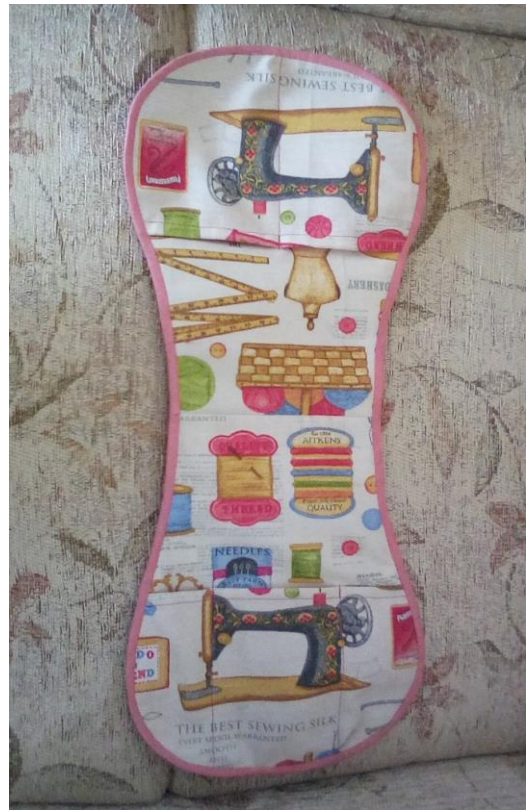


Chair Sewing Tidy



Fat quarter of main fabric and lining
Thin wadding

Place pattern piece on fold, extending edge to make it larger if required, and cut out piece B on main fabric and lining.
Cut 2 pieces of A in main and lining fabric.

With right sides of pocket main and lining, stitch across top. Turn and press wrong sides together and top stitch across top.

Place pocket pieces onto main fabric. Sew down pocket piece to make two or three sections on each piece.

Sandwich wadding between lining and main fabric, pin and sew through all layers close to the edge. Sew bias binding all round.

If you want to make the sewing tidy slightly longer, set the fold line an inch down from the fold, thus adding two inches to the overall length.
