

# Chunky Flower Tea Cosy



Chunky yarn or two strands of Aran yarn

6.5mm needles

DK yarn for flowers

3 ¼ mm needles

This is to fit a straight sided tea pot, 5" tall and 4 ½ " across lid.

It is worked in one piece so keep measuring as you go to make sure it fits your tea pot. Add more or less rows to suit.

Cast on 28 sts and knit 18 rows.

Next row: K1, (k2tog, k4) 4 times, k2tog, k1. 23 sts.

Next row: Purl.

Next row: Knit.

Next row: K2tog, k8, sl1, k2tog, pssso, k8, k2tog. 19 sts.

Next row: Knit.

Next row: K2tog, k6, k2tog, pssso, k6, k2tog. 15 sts.

Knit 17 rows.

Next row: K1, kf&b, k4, kf&b, k1, kf&b, k4, kf&b, k1. 19 sts

Next row: Knit.

Next row: Purl.

Next row: Knit.

Next row: Kf&b, k7, kf&b, K1, kf&b, K7, kf&b. 23 sts.

Next row: Knit

Next row: K1, (kf&b, k4) 4 times, kf&b, k1. 28 sts.

Knit 18 rows.

Cast off.

Fold work over and sew up sides leaving space for handle and spout.

## Flowers

Using dk yarn and 3 ¼ mm needles.

Cast on 60 sts.

Knit 1 row.

K1, cast off 8 sts. Repeat from \* to \* to end. 12 sts.

Cut yarn and thread through sts and pull tight.

Make as many as you wish in various colours and sew to cosy.
