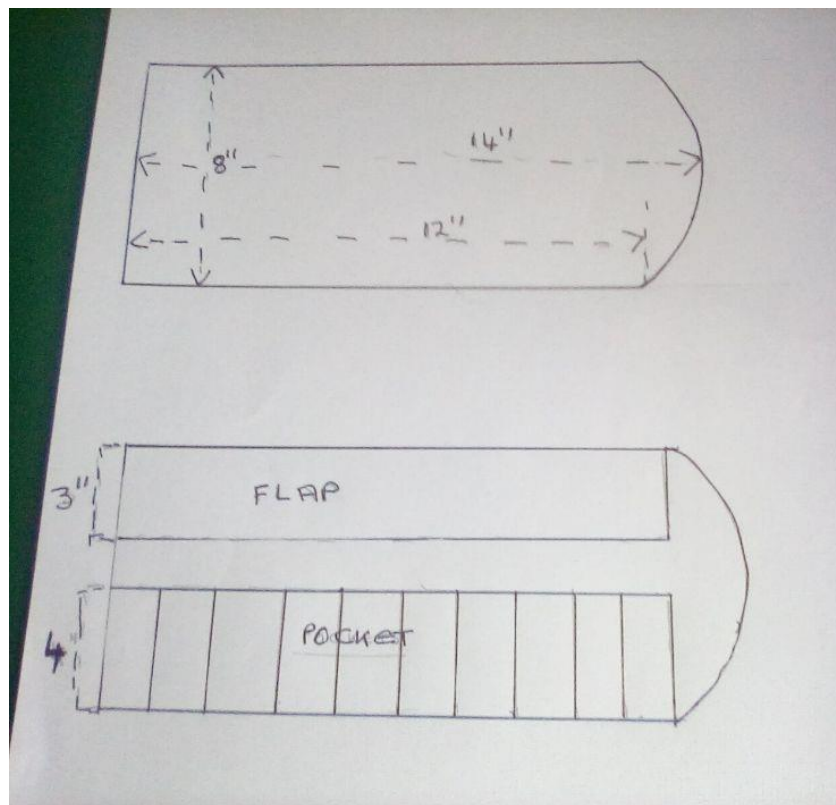


Crochet Hook Roll



Cut three pieces 9" X 15", an outer, an inner and a lining (thin wadding).

Cut one piece 6" X 13" for the flap

Cut 1 Piece 8" X 13" for the pocket.

Cut two strips 18" X 2½" for straps or use ready made tape.

On the right edge of the three main pieces place a saucer and mark a curved edge.

Keep the curved edge to the right.

Fold flap piece in half, right sides together and making sure your pattern will be the right way up when attached, (3" X 13") and sew down the right side. Trim and turn right sides out, press and top stitch along fold and up sewn edge.

Fold strap material in half, lengthwise and stitch. Turn through, press and neaten 1 end of each strap.

Fold pocket piece in half right sides together and stitch down right edge. Again make sure the material is the right way up when placed at bottom of inner piece. Turn through and press and top stitch across folded edge.

On right side of inner material, with curved edge on the right, place the flap at the top, matching left edge and corner. Don't stitch right edge of flap, this needs to be loose to get your hooks in.

Pin the pocket to the bottom and left edge and pin down the right hand side, should be level with the top flap and about 1" gap between the two. Mark 6 or 7 sections about 1 ¼" apart from top of pocket to bottom. Stitch down each section and double stitch the right hand side.

Position the straps to the middle of the curve.

With wrong side of outer piece facing upwards, place the lining/wadding on top and inner piece on top of that. Start pinning all round but slightly pull the inner material tighter than the outer cover (this makes sure it sits better when folded) Sew wide bias binding all round. Add hooks, roll up and tie.
