

Crochet Vegetables



Using DK yarn of suitable colours and 3.5 mm hook

Tomato



With red ch5. Db in 2nd ch from hook and next 2ch. 2db in next ch then db in next 3 loops on other side of chain. Join with ss to 1st ch. 10 db.

Rnd 1. Ch1, 2 db in 1st st, db in next 4 bd, 2 db in next st and db in rem sts. Join. (12)

Rnd 2: ch 1, db in 1st st, 2 db in next st, (db in next st, 2 db in next st) repeat round. Join. (18)
Rnd 3: as rnd 2. (27)
Rnd 4-7: ch1, db in each st.

Rnd 8: ch1,(db in next 7 sts, db dec) 3 times. Join. (24)
Rnd 9: ch1,(db in next 6 sts, db dec) 3 times. Join. (21)
Rnd 10: ch1,(db in next st, db dec) 3 times. Join. (14)
Rnd 11: ch 1, db dec all round. Join. (7)
Stuff and sew up hole.

Leaves and stem

With green join into last round. (Ch 3, sl st in next st) repeat around to form leaves. Join to 1st sl st. Insert hook into centre of leaves, sl st, ch 4, sl st in 2nd ch from hook and each ch across. sl st to beginning and fasten off

Carrot



- 1) Magic ring, 6 db (6)
- 2) 2db in each stitch (12)
- 3) 2db in each stitch (24)
- 4) 1db in each stitch (24)
- 5) 1db in next 3 stitches, then 2db in next stitch, rep to the end of row (30)
- 6-8) 1db in each stitch for 3 rows (30)
- 9) 1db in next 8 stitches, then 2tog – repeat to the end of row (27)
- 10-11) 1db in each st for 2 rows (27)
- 12) 1db in next 7 stitches, then 2tog – repeat to the end of row (24)
- 13-14) 1db in each st for 2 rows (24)
- 15) 1db in next 6 stitches, then 2tog – repeat to the end of row (21)
- 16-17) 1db in each stitch for 2 rows (21) stuff.
- 19-20) 1db in each st for 2 rows (18)
- 21) 1db in next 4 stitches, then 2tog – repeat to the end of row (15)
- 22) 1db in each stitch (15)
- 23) 1db in next 3 stitches, then 2tog – repeat to the end of row (12)
- 24) 1db in each stitch (12)

- 25) 1db in next 2 stitches, then 2tog – repeat to the end of row (9)
- 26) 1db in each stitch (9)
- 27) 1db, then 2tog – repeat to end (6)
- 28) 2tog to the end fasten off leaving a length for root.

Leaves

- 1) Ch 10 (10)
- 2) Starting from 2nd chain from the hook, make 1db in next 9 stitches (9) Make 5 leaves and sew to top of carrot.

Sweetcorn



Body:

Start with Yellow

1. Ch 2. 6 sc.
2. 2 sc around. (12 sts)
3. Sc around. (12 sts)
4. 1 sc, inc. repeat around. (18 sts)
5. Sc around. (18 sts)
6. 2 sc, inc. repeat around. (24 sts)
7. Sc around. (24 sts)
- 8 - 13. Repeat 7.

Switch to green

- 14 -27. Repeat 7.
28. 2 sc, dec. repeat around. (18 sts)
29. Sc around (18 sts)

Start stuffing

30. 1 sc, dec. repeat around. (12 sts)

31. Sc around (12 sts)

32. Dec around. (6 sts)

Ss and fasten off. Use the remaining tail to sew up the hole in the bottom.

Sew in the ends.

Leaves:

Use green

1. Ch 13. Sc in 2nd ch from hook. Sc across. (12 sts)

2. Ch 1. Turn. Sc across. (12 sts)

3. Ch 1. Turn. Dec. sc across until last 2 sts. Dec. (10 sts)

4. Ch 1. Turn. Sc across. (10 sts)

5. Repeat 3. (8 sts)

6. Repeat 4. (8 sts)

7. Repeat 3. (6 sts)

8. Repeat 4. (6 sts)

9. Repeat 3. (4 sts)

10. Repeat 4. (4 sts)

11. Repeat 3. (2 sts)

12. Repeat 4. (2 sts)

13. Ch 1. Turn. Dec.

14. Ch 1. Turn. Sc around the entire leaf.

Fasten off.. Repeat for the 2nd leaf.

Attach the leaves to the main body of the corn where you change colour.

Peas



Ch2, 6 db in 1st ch.

Rnd 1: 2 db in each st. (12)

Rnd 2: * db, 2 db in next st * repeat around. (18)

Rnds 3 – 5: dbl in each st.

Rnd 6: *db, db 2tog * repeat round (12) Firmley stuff.

Rnd 7: Db 2tog around. (6)

Weave yarn through last sts pull up and sew together.

Pod

Ch 26. Row 1: Starting in 2nd ch from hook work 25 db across.

Row 2: Db in each st.

Row 3: Sl st into first two sts, db into next 21 sts and turn (miss last 2 sts).

Row 4: Sl st into first two sts, db into next 17 sts and turn.

Row 5: 1 ch and 17 db.

Rows 6 – 9: Repeat row 5 4 times.

Do not turn and now work 3 dbs down side and continue to work dbs around piece to reach starting chain.

Working into loops from starting chain work second side as above. To finish, work a row of dbs all round.

Sew peas to bottom seam of pod and sew up ends enclosing peas.
