

Halloween Child's Devil Hat



Size 4mm knitting needles

Size 4 mm crochet hook

Note: this pattern requires both
knitting and crochet.

Cast on 70 stitches

K for 7 rows.

Change to Stocking Stitch and work
until piece measure 4.5 inches from
cast on edge ending with a purl row.
(K4, k2tog) repeat across, K last 4
stitches (59)

Purl 1 row

(K3, k2tog) repeat across, K last 4
stitches (48)

Purl 1 row

(K2, k2tog) repeat across (36)

Purl 1 row

(K1, k2tog) repeat across (24)

Purl 1 row

(k2tog) repeat across (12)

Fasten off. Leave a long tail for
sewing. Thread tail through
remaining stitches and pull up tight to
close. Sew back seam with mattress

stitch.

Horns.

Ch 2

4 dc in 2nd ch from hook.

Working in continuous rounds, place
a marker on the 1st st of each round.

2 dc in 1st st, 3 dc (5)

2 dc in 1st st, 4 dc (6)

2 dc in 1st st, 5 dc (7)

2 dc in 1st st, 6 dc (8)

2 dc in 1st st, 7 dc (9)

2 dc in 1st st, 8 dc (10)

2 dc in 1st st, 9 dc (11)

2 dc in 1st st, 10 dc (12)

Fasten off. Leave long tail for sewing.

Stuff horns and sew to hat.

For a larger size just add a few more
stitches and a few more rows.
