

Lifeboat Trauma Teddy



Size 10 (3.25mm) and 8 (4mm) needles
Double knitting wool in Black, Yellow, Beige, Red, Grey and White

Legs and Body.

1. Using 3 ¼ mm needles cast on 10 sts in yellow and knit 14 rows.
2. Change to black and knit 24 rows. Make another trouser leg in the same way.
3. Knit across all 20 sts and work 8 rows.
4. Change to yellow and knit 8 rows.
5. Change to black and knit 4 rows.
6. Change to yellow and knit 24 rows

Head

7. Change to beige and stocking stitch for about 6 ½ " about 56 rows.

Body and Legs

8. Change to yellow and knit 24 rows.
9. Change to black and knit 4 rows.
10. Change to yellow and knit 8 rows.
11. Change to black and knit 8 rows.

12. Working on first 10 sts knit 24 rows in black,
13. Change to yellow and knit 14 rows. Cast off.
14. Rejoin black to remaining 10 sts and knit 24 rows.
15. Change to yellow and knit 14 rows. Cast off.

Arms

1. Using yellow, pick up 8 sts either side of neck/head join (16 sts). Knit 20 rows.
2. Change to beige and knit 10 rows. Cut yarn and thread through sts and pull tight. Repeat on other side.

To make up.

Sew head seams and diagonal across the top corners to form ears. Sew up teddy leaving a hole in one seam, stuff and stitch hole closed.

Sew a running thread around neck and pull up to shape neck and head.
Sew in ends.

Embroider a happy teddy face.

Sew a black line up front of jacket.

Life Jacket

Using 4mm needles cast on 5 sts.

Work in st st for about 11½" or until it wraps from belt round neck and down to belt.

Wrap and sew to teddy securely.

Embroider or stick on RNLI letters.

Helmet

With 4mm needles and white dk yarn cast on 8 sts.

1 and every alt row. Purl.

2. K f & B in every st (14 sts)

4. (k1, k f&b in next st) to end (24sts)

6. (k2, k f&b in next st) to end (32 sts)

8. (k3, k f&b in next st) to end (40 sts)

10. (k4, k f&b in next st) to end (48 sts)

11-14. Beg with purl row st-st 4 rows

15. P16, K16, P16

16. K16, cast off 16, k16.

Working on first set of 16 sts.

17. Purl 1 row.

18. K2tog, knit to end

19. Purl to last 2 sts and p2tog.

20. K2tog, knit to end

21. K to last 2 sts, k2tog. (12 sts)

Cast off.

Rejoin to other side and work as above reversing shaping.

Sew in ends and down back seam.

Sew helmet to top of head.

Visor

Using 3 ¼ needles and grey yarn cast on 25 sts.

Purl 1 row.

Starting with a purl row st-st 4 rows

Knit 1 row and cast off.

Stitch side edges to front of helmet.
