

Donny Donkey (and yes he only has two legs)



Dk yarn in main, nose and feet colours
3 ¾ mm needles (9 uk)

Body.

Cast on 22 sts in main colour and knit 44 rows.
Change to nose colour and knit 6 rows.
Cut yarn and thread through stitches pulling up tight.

Legs. (2)

Cast on 12 sts in foot colour and knit 2 rows.
Change to main colour and knit 16 rows.
Cast off.

Ears.

Cast on 6 sts in main colour and knit 16 rows.
Decrease 1 st at each end of row.
Knit 1 row.
Repeat last two rows. Knit two sts together and fasten off.

Make up.

Sew across foot and side of legs. Lightly stuff.
Position legs into bottom seam, positioning them towards the back and sew up back seam and across bottom seam sewing through top of legs as you go.
Stuff and sew up last of seam.
Sew in eyes and nostrils.
Pleat bottom of ears and sew to top of head.
Cut 6 short lengths each of main and foot colours and using a crochet hook insert 3 of each colour behind ears for mane and on top of back seam for a tail.
