

Shoulder Wrap Granny Square Style



Approx 20" (20") wide and 64" (80") long

Dk yarn and 4 mm hook.

The small size fits comfortably around the shoulders of a small adult and the larger around a larger person. However this can be made as long or short as you wish, just alter the number of cast on stitches and number of rounds to suit.

Work a length of " no chain cast on " of 165 (195) trebles. "No chain cast on" is very easy to do but difficult to explain. Look on Google or youtube for instructions. Alternatively work 168 (198) ch and start in the 3rd ch from the hook.

You will now work around all 4 sides of the cast on.

Round 1: 3ch (miss if working a chain). 2tr, 1ch, 3 tr into middle of last tr. * miss 2 sts, 3 tr into next tr. Repeat to end of row. Work 3tr, 1 ch, 3tr, twice into middle of last st at end of cast on. Now working down second side work from * to end making sure your 3 tr's are opposite each other. At the end of this side work 3 tr, 1ch 3tr into same place as the first ones. Ss to join.

Round 2: 2 ch, 2tr into space below ss. Work 3tr, 1 ch, 3tr, into 1ch space (corner) and continue working 3 tr's and corners all round.

Work 24 rounds in total. Then work three rounds of htr to make a border. If using small random coloured balls of yarn, join securely and sew in the ends as you go rather than leaving them to the end.
