

### Small Christmas Puddings

These can have a hanging loop for a tree or just sit beside a plate on the table. Stuff them with any round wrapped chocolate, such as a Ferrero Rocher.



Use Double Knit and size 3.75 needles

Cast on 20 stitches in Brown wool

Row 1 - Knit

Row 2 - Purl, increasing in the first and last stitch – 22 stitches

Row 3 – Knit

Row 4 – Purl

Row 5 – Knit

Row 6 – Knit

Row 7 – Knit

Row 8 – Purl

Change to White or Cream wool

Knit 2 rows

Next row – K 2 tog across the row – 11 stitches

Next row – Knit

Next Row – Knit one, knit 2 tog to end of row – 6 stitches

Next row – Knit 2 tog to end – 3 stitches

Thread wool through and gather up. Join side with white/cream wool to middle and with brown wool from cast on tail to middle.

### Holly Leaves

Cast on one stitch

Knit into front and back – 2 stitches

Knit into front and back at the beginning of each row till you get to 5 stitches

Knit 2 rows

Knit 2 tog at the beginning of each row till you get to one stitch

Don't fasten off, but start again and make another leaf. Then fasten off

Weave the cast on tail to the middle of the two leaves and the cast off tail to the middle through the other leaf. Thread each tail through the top of the pudding, turn inside out, knot together and trim ends.

### Berries – Make 2

Cast on 3 stitches

Thread yarn through stitches, cut yarn and knot cast on and cast off tails together tightly.

Thread the two ends of one berry through the pudding either side of the leaves, turn inside out, and trim.

Repeat with the second berry on the other side of the leaves.

### Loop – optional

Crochet a chain about 4 inches long. Or cast on one stitch and knit it for 4 inches, cast off.

Thread the one tail through the pudding next to a berry and the other tail next to the other berry. Turn inside out and knot together and trim.

Pop in a Fererro Rocher chocolate.
