

Syringe Driver Bag



Cut two rectangles of fabric 60cm x 25cm. These can be made from smaller pieces as above or just two contrasting pieces.

Strap - Cut a piece of fabric 140cm x 12cm. Again this could be composite. Fold in and iron 2cm all round. Now fold in half lengthways, wrong sides together. Sew all round.

Bag – Take the two large rectangles and place right sides together. Stitch the two longer and one shorter side using 2cm seams. Turn and press.

Tab – cut two rectangles about 6 x 10 cm. It can be shaped at one end. Place right sides together and stitch three sides. Turn and press. Stitch a piece of Velcro at the shaped end.

On the open edge fold in 2cm and press. Place the tab in the middle between the layers. Now stitch across the width of the bag.

Next fold the rectangle in half lengthways and stitch the side seams through all four layers, 1cm from the edge.

Open out these seams at the top and position the straps. Sew in place. Fold over the tab to mark the position of the second piece of Velcro and secure in place. Your finished bag should be about 27cm x 22cm (11" x 9")
