

Easy PC Knitting Pattern Modern Police Constable. By Lyn Milns

Black DK – skin tone DK - Size 4mm Needles – Toy Stuffing.



Policeman

With black wool cast on 48 stitches and work 24 rows in stocking stitch

Knit 10 sts in black, 4 sts in skin tone, 20 sts in black, 4 sts in Skin tone, 10 sts black Keeping colours like this do 3 more rows in stocking stitch.

With black wool only continue in stocking stitch for 14 rows.

Next row Knit 2 tog across all stitches

Next row Purl

Change to skin tone and continue in stocking stitch for 12 rows

Next row knit tog across all stitches

Next row Purl

Next row knit tog across all stitches Thread wool through remaining stitches.

Sew up back seam leaving a gap put stuffing in, stuff and sew. Sew running stitches around neck to pull in. Mark out legs and arms by stitching through toy. Sew POLICE in white on black ribbon and sew on chest. Sew POLICE in white on blue ribbon and sew on back.

Policeman Cap

Cap is knitted in two main parts – side band and the tip. The peak is knitted onto the side band once the cap has been stitched together.

Inc 1 – knit into front and back of stitch. Ssk slip the first stitch as if to knit, knit 1, then slide the slipped stitch over knitted stitch.

Side band

Cast on 28 sts in black and purl 1 row.

Next row: K1 Inc1 in next stitch to last 2 sts, K2. (41 sts) Work 3 rows in st st, beg with a p row. Cast off.

Tip

Cast on 5 sts

1st row: inc1, K3, inc1. (7 sts) Next row: P.

Next row: (inc1) twice, K to last 3 sts, (inc1) twice, K1. (11 sts) Next row: P.

Rep last 2 rows once more. (15 sts) Next row: inc1, K12, inc1, K1. (17 sts) Work 7 rows in st st, beg with a P row.

Next row. K1, k2tog, K11, ssk, K1. (15 sts) Next row: P.

Next row: K1, (k2tog) twice, K5, (ssk) twice, K1. (11 sts) Next row: P.

Next row: K1, (k2tog) twice, K1, (ssk) twice, K1. (7 sts) Cast off purl wise.

Join the short edges of the side band. With the right sides of your work facing you, place the tip on the side band so that your rows of knitting run across the side band. Sew the tip to the side band.

Peak

Pick up and K 11 sts across front of the side band. Next row: P.

Next row K1, K2 tog, K5, ssk, K1 (9 sts) Next Row P

Next row K1,K2 tog, K3, ssk, K1 (7sts) Next row P2 tog, P3, P2 tog (5st)

Next row K1, m1, K to last st, m1,K1 (7st) Next row P

Rep last 2 rows once more (9sts) Cast off purlwise.

Fold the cast-off edge of the peak under, oversew the sides of peak together and the cast- off edge of peak to the inside of the side band

Check Band can be done by sewing rows of white stitches or by putting black and white gingham ribbon 5mm around side band.

Stitch cap on to the head.
