

Walking Frame Bag



This is the simplest type to make. Finished, it measures 15 inches by 12 inches deep. The measurement is not crucial.

Cut two rectangles of fabric approximately 13 by 16 inches.

Cut a third rectangle several inches shorter (9-10"). This will form the pocket. Finish one of the longer edges by turning in a small amount and then a further half inch. Stitch. Lay on top of one of the larger rectangles, right sides upwards, matching the bottom and sides. Now stitch down vertically to form two pockets.

Place the second large rectangle on top so that right sides are facing. Stitch round three sides leaving the top open.

Turn and press.

Press in half an inch on the raw edges. Pin the ties in position. These could be bias binding, ribbon or fabric.

Stitch along the top edge fairly close to the edge.



This one is made from bits and pieces of fabric. It needs to measure 30-36 inches by 15-18 inches. It goes over the top of the frame and fastens with velcro.

The right side is a series of pockets. Make sure they are facing the right direction!

The reverse is just one piece. Sew on two pieces of Velcro as shown.

The principle is then same, place right sides together and stitch remembering to leave an opening for turning. Turn and topstitch all the way round.
