

## **A simple shell edging for a granny square .**

Make sure you have an odd number of spaces counting from one corner edge to the next corner edge.

Make a double crochet (dc), 3 spaces to the right of any corner, then work 7 half treble crochet (htc) into the next space and dc in the following space.

Work 9htc in the corner space into this and every corner space.

Make a dc into the next space and 7 htc in the following space.

Continue in this fashion around your granny square, until you get back to the beginning. Join with a slip stitch to the first double crochet.

The edging can be used on blankets, hats and sleeve cuffs.
