

Ways to use those oddments of wool!

We often receive small quantities of various wool and our knitters use their creative skills to decide how best to use them.

Knitting stripes.

Our knitters often use this great way to knit up those oddments. In these garments the knitters have used a variety of ways to include stripes and give some colourful effects.

Using up mohair oddments



In this jumper the rib for the back and front, the sleeves and the neck have been knitted in different colours. A close-up of the pattern shows that a mohair wool has been used above the blue stripe. A good way to use up mohair oddments!

Another colourful neck rib



Different striped patterns in the centre of the jumper and then a repeat of the first pattern for the neck, make this another colourful use of oddments.

Changing the stitch

The stripes in this jumper are created with a multi-coloured wool and made more effective by changing the stocking stitch to garter stitch.
